\$83 Million To Be Invested In First Stage Of Tourism Complex In Chihuahua State

On Jan. 22, Fernando Baeza Melendez, governor of Chihuahua state, said \$83 million will be invested in the first construction phase of the "Lago de la Colina, Chihuahua" tourism complex. This stage of the project is expected to last six years. Baeza Melendez said the project will have an annual capacity of 100,000 tourists and employ 2,750 workers. The general plan includes 5,400 filtered hectares (a lake and supporting urbanization) to be located not more than 120 kilometers south of the city of Chihuahua. (Source: Notimex, 01/22/91)
