2.8% Unemployment In September 1990

According to the National Informatics, Geography and Statistics Institute (INEGI), the open unemployment rate for September last year for the nation's 16 largest urban areas was 2.8%, down 0.2% compared to August. Unemployment for men was 2.5% (down 0.2%), and 3.3% for women (down 0.4%). The lowest rates were recorded in Leon (1.3%), and Merida (1.5%). At the opposite extreme were Monterrey (3.6%), and Tampico (3.4%). (Source: El Financiero, 01/09/91)
