According to a report released Jan. 9 by the Banco de Mexico (central bank), for 1990 as a whole the consumer price index (INPC) rose 29.9%, compared to 19.7% in 1989. The INPC's global categories registering the highest price hikes last year were housing at 40%, and transportation, 35.6%.
