 SUBJECT: Meeting to Elect Officers

The new Senate will meet on Tuesday, May 12, at 3:00 p.m. in the Vice to elect officers -- President, Vice President, and the Nominations Committee.

According to Senate Bylaws:

- The election of the President, Vice President, and Nominations Committee members shall be conducted annually at a special meeting of the Faculty Senate held at the close of the spring term of the preceding academic year.
- Nominating petitions for Senate President and Vice President, signed by at least three senators from the incoming Senate, may be submitted to the University Secretary in advance of the special meeting. Additional nominations may be made from the floor at the special meeting.
- Nominations for Vice President shall not be from the same school or college as that of the President.
- The three additional elected members of the Operations Committee shall be from different schools or colleges.
