Certificate of Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of "Huning & Connell" (No Stockholders' Liability), a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of New Mexico:

Huning & Connell (No Stockholders' Liability), a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of New Mexico, by Fred D. Huning, its President, and H. Emory Davis, its Secretary, does hereby certify:

1. That the principal office of said Huning & Connell (no stockholders' liability) in the State of New Mexico is at Los Lunas, County of Valencia, State of New Mexico, and that the name of the agent therein and in charge thereof, and upon whom process against the corporation may be served is Fred D. Huning, whose postoffice address is Los Lunas, New Mexico.

2. That the Board of Directors of said corporation at a meeting duly convened and held at the office of said company in Los Lunas, County of Valencia, State of New Mexico, on the 20th day of May, 1920, passed a resolution declaring that it is advisable to change the name of said corporation, as in said resolution referred to, and calling a meeting of the stockholders to take action thereon, which said resolution was in words and figures as follows:

"Whereas it has been deemed advisable by the Board of Directors of Huning & Connell (no stockholders' liability) that the articles of incorporation of said company be amended so as to change the name of said company from its present name of 'Huning & Connell' to 'Huning Mercantile Company' (no stockholders' liability):

"Now therefore be it resolved that a special meeting of the stockholders of Huning & Connell be called for the 21st day of May, 1920, pursuant to the by-laws, at the hour of 9 o'clock A. M. of said day at the office of said company at Los Lunas, New Mexico, to take action on said proposed amendment."

3. That pursuant to said resolution, and upon due notice as the by-laws of said corporation provide, as provided by section 914 of the New Mexico Statutes Annotated, 1915, and on said 21st day of May, 1920, at the hour of 9 o'clock A. M. of said day, pursuant to call, a special meeting of the stockholders of said company was held, at which meeting all of the stockholders were present in person or by proxy and that all of said stockholders having voting powers voted in favor of such resolution and amendment by resolution of said stockholders in words and figures as follows:

"Whereas it has been considered advisable by the Board of Directors of Huning & Connell (no stockholders' liability) and is now considered advisable by the stockholders thereof in meeting assembled that the articles of incorporation of said company be amended so as to change the name of said company from 'Huning & Connell' to 'Huning Mercantile Company' (no stockholders' liability):

"And be it further resolved, that the officers of this corporation be and they are hereby authorized to make and execute any and all certificates in the premises."

COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

SPECIAL SESSION, JUNE 21, 1920.

The Board of County Commissioners of Valencia county met in special session June 21, 1920. There were present: Hon. Manuel Garcia, chairman; Tranquilino Jaramillo and Abel Vigil, members of the board; Fred Tondre, deputy assessor; Placido Jaramillo, sheriff, and Diego Aragon, county clerk.

The minutes of the two previous sessions were read and approved.

The county clerk is hereby instructed to write to the director of the Taxpayers' Association in behalf of the Board of County Commissioners of Valencia county, inviting him to be present in Los Lunas, N. M., at their regular session on the 6th day of July and assist them in making the levies for the year 1920 taxes.

The county clerk is hereby instructed to draw warrant upon the special bridge fund of the amount of \$881.90 (Eight Hundred and Eighty-one and 90/100 Dollars) to The Midland Bridge Company of Kansas City, Mo., in payment of certificate of indebtedness of \$864.51 and interest on same due said company.

Be it resolved that the purchasing agent be and is hereby instructed and authorized to employ and make all arrangements necessary for the painting of the court house and jail roofings and all outside framings of said buildings, and also for the calomining of the inside walls of said court house and also to provide proper sewerage for said buildings and to purchase all material necessary.

The Board of County Commissioners then adjourned as a Board of County Commissioners and immediately reconvened as a County Board of Equalization.

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J. B. Wilson-Antonio Sedillo grant claim on reduction of value on land rejected.

J. B. Wilson-Antonio Sedillo land grant reduced 250 head of cows, \$9,738.00.

District No. 2.

Seferino Esquibel reduced on real estate, \$532.00.

District No. 3.

Juan Gallegos, exemption as ex-soldier allowed.

District No. 5.

Mr. and Mrs. Emil Bibb, claim rejected.

District No. 9.

Placido Padilla, reduced five acres land, No. 1, \$300.00.

District No. 16.

Mrs. J. E. Tietjen, reduced on personal property \$27,216.00.

Messrs. Teleforo Mirabal, J. M. Luna and Valentin Jaramillo, representing, respectively, the Seboyeta, Plaza de Juan Tofaya and the Belen land Grants, appeared before the Board of Equalization of the County of Valencia, appealing from the valuation of \$2.25 per acre assessed upon the land of the respective grants represented by them, claiming that this valuation is excessive, exorbitant and greatly above the present market value of such lands, and stated that the total income from the above mentioned respective bodies of land is inadequate to pay for the taxes on a valuation of \$2.25 per acre.

After taking this matter under due consideration the Board of Equalization adopted the following resolution: Whereas, it appears to the satisfaction of the Board of Equalization of Valencia county that the valuation placed upon the lands mentioned above is excessive, but it further appears that the assessor, in placing said valuation, complied with the orders of the State Tax Commission of the State of New Mexico, and this board feels that it lacks authority to make any deduction from the value fixed by the State Tax Commission. THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the foregoing appeals hereby be denied.

In the matter of the assessment of the Antonio Sedillo grant: Comes now the executors of the last will and testament of J. B. Wilson, deceased by their attorneys, Marron & Wood, protesting against the action of the State Tax Commission in fixing the valuation of the land of the Antonio Sedillo grant at \$2.25 per acre, and on the action of the assessor in following the direction of the State Tax Commission, and after hearing O. N. Marron, and being sufficiently advised:

It is ordered that in as much as this board feels that it is without authority or jurisdiction to fix a different or other valuation than \$2.25 an acre, the one fixed by the State Tax Commission, though said board feels that said valuation is excessive:

It is hereby ordered that the assessment of \$2.25 an acre is hereby ordered to stand and the action of the assessor is approved for the assessment aforesaid.

Claim of \$125.28 by H. W. Perry for the installation of new engine and batteries in court house was allowed.

Being no other business before the board it adjourned subject to call of the chairman.

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A FOOL AND HIS BOND SOON PART

A discontented scowl clouded Joe Peterson's brow as he crumpled up the afternoon paper. "Liberty Bonds are down again," he grumbled to Bill Coleman who sat beside him. "I don't see it," said Joe stubbornly. "They're Government obligations and the Government ought to keep 'em good at their face value."

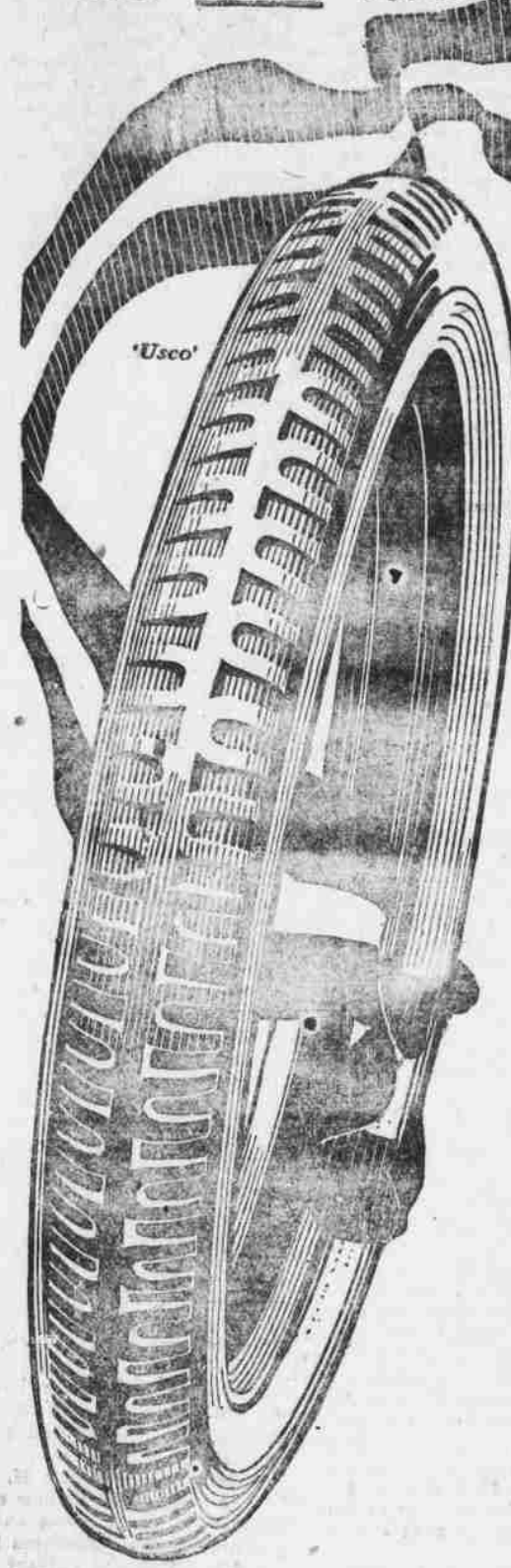

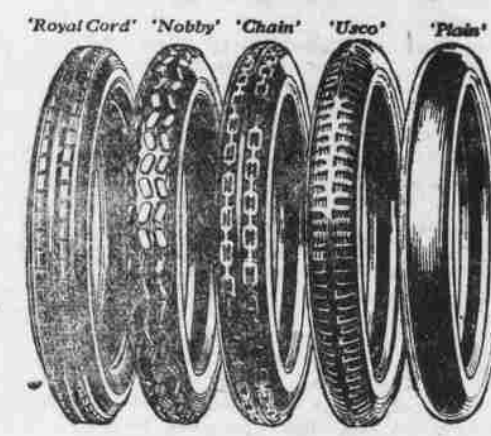
