STATE FIRE MARSHAL INVESTS THIRD OF INCOME IN LIBERTY BONDS MONTHLY

Austin, Texas.—Hon. A. P. Woolbridge, former banker, long mayor of Austin, now state fire marshal, writes that he is investing at least one-third of his monthly income in Liberty Bonds, which he tells Dinsmore W.
