## **Government Plans \$18.5 Million Investment In Transport Infrastructure For Coahuila State**

On Feb. 3, Transportation and Communications Secretary Andres Caso Lombardo told reporters that the ministry plans to invest more than \$18.5 million in transport infrastructure projects in Coahuila state. Most of the new investment is earmarked for construction of the Torreon-Salttillo highway, and the modernization and expansion of existing highway and rural road systems.
