General Motors Plant Workers End Strike

On Feb. 10, nearly 2,600 workers at the General Motors de Mexico plant in the Mexico City metropolitan area ended a strike after the US-based company approved a 23% wage hike, and a 6.5% increase in benefits. Employees launched the strike on Feb. 9 after management rejected demands for a 30% pay hike, and improved housing, education and nutrition benefits. (Source: Notimex, 02/10/91)
