## REGULAR ADJOURNED MEETING, JULY 29TH, 1921

The Board of County Commissioners of Valencia County, met as per adjournment of July 6th. There were present, Hon. Daniel Lucero chairman of the board, Hon. Narciso Frances, and Hon. Celso Lobato members, Hon. Joseph F. Tondre sheriff and A. A. Gutierrez county clerk.  
The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.  
Mr. Maximiliano Sanchez and other citizens of Belen appeared before the board, as requested by the board in the previous meeting through a resolution, to show cause why a certain road they leads from Los Lecos passed the house of Placido Chavez to Rio Puerco should not be declared a public road. After due consideration to this matter, both parties concerned made a satisfactory agreement to wit: Mr. Sanchez and the other citizens opposed to this road agreed to give the same, provided the road is not more than (12) twelve feet wide and on condition that Procopio Sanchez and the other citizens sign in the petition shall supply Maximiliano Sanchez with enough posts and barbed wire to make a three-wire fence about 275 yards more or less, on his property where the road is situated.  
Hon. Joseph F. Tondre reported to the board that a certain Chas. Brady was wounded while resisting arrest

by officers, and to save his life was taken to a hospital at Gallup, New Mexico for immediate medical treatment; and the board under the circumstances ordered that Mr. Tondre use all efforts so that this wounded man be removed from where he is and taken to the Insane Asylum, at Las Vegas, under an order and commitment from the District Court, as soon as practicable so that the expense upon the county will not be any larger than absolutely possible.  
Mr. J. W. Chapman appeared before the board in behalf of Mr. Nicholas Hausner, of Closson, New Mexico, and Mr. J. J. Emmmons at Gallup, New Mexico, respectively in regard to Certificate of sale for taxes and the board after due consideration on this matter passed the following resolution:  
Whereas it has been made to appear to this board that certificates for sale for taxes No. 340, 245 and 335 has been issued and recorded more than three years and no purchaser has appeared, therefore be it resolved that the County Treasurer be requested and directed to proceed to take tax deeds in the name of the county of Valencia under the provisions house bill No. 100 which was regularly passed by the last legislature of 1921 and  
Whereas Mr. Nicholas Hausner of Closson, New Mexico acting through Mr. J. W. Chapman his attorney, has appeared before this board and has offered to purchase the tax deed, issued on tax sales No. 340, 245 and 335 offered to pay thereon the sum equal to 15 per cent of the amount of taxes and interest due on said taxes, and whereas Mr. J. J. Emmmons of Gallup, New Mexico, acting through his attorney Mr. J. W. Chapman has appeared before this board and offered to purchase the tax deeds issued on tax sales No. 255 and 340 and has offered to pay on same the sum equal to the whole amount of taxes and interest due on certificate No. 255 and the sum equal to 80 per cent of the amount of taxes and interest due on certificate No. 340.  
Be it further resolved that the offer of Mr. Hausner and Mr. Emmmons be accepted, provided that the consent of the state Tax Commission be had thereto.  
Be it Further Resolved that the clerk of this board communicate with the State Tax Commission for the purpose of securing its consent of said sale.  
Be it Further Resolved that as soon as said consent is received the County Treasurer, shall sell and assign the said tax deeds issued to the county, on tax sales certificate No. 340 to the said Nicholas Hausner and Certificate No. 255 and 335 respectively to the said J. J. Emmmons.  
Whereas the county of Valencia is indebted to the Midland Bridge Company on certificate of indebtedness No. 2, in the amount of \$10,150.00 with interest thereon, which indebtedness has to be paid out of the Special Bridge Fund, and whereas there are only about \$4,500 in said fund and the Midland Bridge Company is willing to receive said amount in partial payment, therefore be it resolved that the county clerk is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant in favor of the Midland Bridge Company in the amount of \$4,500, as partial payment of said certificate of indebtedness No. 2, and the chairman of the board is hereby authorized to sign the same.  
Resolved by the board of county commissioners that the county clerk is hereby authorized and instructed to draw warrants against the Wild Animal Pound Fund, in payment of claims of said fund from time to time when there is money available in said fund, and payments shall be made beginning with the oldest claim. And the chairman of this board is hereby authorized to sign the said warrants.  
Mr. Abel Vigil appeared before the board in support of a petition presented by Mr. Gregorio Aragon y Baca from Valencia requesting of the board that some financial aid must be given to Precinct No. 11 and 22 for a needed drainage in order to save the crops of many citizens, that are being damaged by waters that accu-

late around their farms. The board after giving due consideration to the matter appointed the following committee to investigate and report with its recommendation to the board the following were appointed: Abel Vigil, Miguel Silva, and Manuel Vigil.  
Whereas it has been made to appear to this board that the Maxwell automobile owned by the county of Valencia is of no service to the county, it was resolved by the board of County Commissioners that Hon. Joseph F. Tondre is hereby authorized and directed to sell the said automobile for cash, for the amount not less than \$200.00, and to report to this board the amount for which the same was sold, duly certified.
