On Feb. 22, spokespersons for Fertilizantes Mexicanos (FERTIMEX) said that the sale on Feb. 21 of the Coatzacoalcos plant will be finalized in the first week of March. The plant is the first of five to be privatized. The others are located in Salamanca, Guadalajara, Torreon, and Monclova. The 650-ha. Coatzacoalcos facility is located in Cosaliacaque, Veracruz state. Annual output is about 359 metric tons of fertilizer. (Source: Notimex, 02/21/91)
