REGULAR SESSION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS HELD OCT. 3, 1921.

The board of county commissioners of Valencia County met in regular session October 3, 1921. There were present Hon. Daniel Lucero chairman of the board, Hon. Narciso Frances and Selso Lobato, members, Hon. Joseph F. Tondre sheriff and A. A. Gutierrez county clerk.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. Mr. Adelino Sanchez appeared before the board in behalf of his claim which claim was referred to the State School Auditor at Santa Fe, for his recommendation and as no word has been received from him to date, the clerk was instructed to communicate with the said school auditor and find out what his opinion is on this matter.

A committee of citizens from precinct No. 12 appeared before the board protesting against the change made by said board on January 17, 1921 in the precinct boundaries between precinct No. 12 and 13, this matter having been deferred for final consideration. After listening to members of the committee and citizens from precinct No. 13 the board decided not to reconsider its previous action taken on January 17th, 1921.

Mr. Jesus C. Sanchez in behalf of the committee from precinct No. 12 reserved the appeal from the action of the board.

A petition from various citizens from the western part of the county around Tinajas in regard to the creation of a new precinct was taken under consideration and the request was denied.

Be it resolved by the board of county commissioners that the county is hereby instructed to draw warrants in the amount authorized by law for the payment of Registration, for the special election held on September 20th, 1921.

The county clerk was instructed to draw warrants in payment to the various county officers according to law, for the quarter ending September 30th, 1921. Also several claims against the county were approved and ordered paid.

The report of the county clerk for the months of July and August were approved. Also reports of the county treasurer for the months of July and August were approved. Reports of Joseph F. Tondre sheriff, were approved for said months. The county road superintendent presented his reports for the months July, August and September, 1921 and the same were approved as were audited and approved vouchers in payment of road expenditures for the quarter ending September 30, 1921. Report of county health officer for the quarter ending September 30, 1921 was approved by the board.

Be it resolved that a levy of one half (1-2) mill on each dollar of taxable property within the county of Valencia is hereby levied under the provisions of Chapter 143 of the laws of 1921, for the County Health fund.

Be it further resolved that the board of county commissioners of Valencia County hereby requests the State Department of Public Welfare to recommend to it for appointment the names of one or more competent persons for County Health Officer, preference to be given to such persons who speak both the English and Spanish languages and being familiar with the habits and customs of the residents of central New Mexico.

The county clerk is hereby authorized and directed to include in the warrant made this day by the board of County Commissioners of Valencia County to the Assessor of said county all levies certified by the proper State Authorities.

A levy of five mills for the Village of Belen as per resolution of Trustees was approved.

Being no other business before the board it adjourned to meet subject to the call of the chairman.
