Cananea Copper Mine Output To Increase 20% In 1991

On Feb. 13, spokespersons for the Cananea copper mining complex (Compania Mexicana de Cananea-CMC) said total output this year is expected to increase by 20% relative to 1990. From over 60 million metric tons of extracted materials, CMC output in 1991 will consist of about 337,000 MT of copper concentrate, 13,000 MT of copper cathodes, and 44,500 MT of semi-refined (blister) copper.
