## 1990 Pemex Production Statistics

On Feb. 27, Petroleos Mexicanos reported that in 1990, production averaged 2.548 million barrels per day, up 1.37% over 1989. Of the total, 1.22 million consisted of heavy crude. Off-shore deposits accounted for an average 1.794 million bpd, followed by the Chiapas-Tabasco oilfields at 576,000 bpd. In 1990, a mean 1.2706 million bpd were domestically refined and consumed. Next, natural gas output last year totaled 3.651 billion cubic feet, a 2.16% increase compared to 1989. (Source: Agence France-Presse, 02/27/91)
