On Feb. 25, Rep. Kika de la Garza, chairperson of the US House Agricultural Committee, said that Mexico and the US should establish an agreement on tuna permitting the US to catch tuna in Mexico's territorial waters. He added that such measure is reasonable, given the migratory nature of the species. According to de la Garza, the proposed agreement would be separate from the free trade accord, although it would conform to GATT regulations. (Source: El Financiero, 02/26/91)
