U. S. STAMP DUTIES.

The following is a partial list of Stamp duties that are required to be paid by the laws of the United States as now in force.

Memorandum of sale, or broker's note. (See Contract.) Mortgage of lands, estate, or property, real or personal, heritable or movable, whatsoever, trust deed in the nature of a mortgage, or any personal bond given as security for the payment of any definite or certain sum of money, exceeding \$100, and not exceeding \$500, and not exceeding \$1,000.
