According to an article appearing in the March 26 issue of El Financiero, in 1990 salaries accounted for 34.8% of the federal budget, compared to 24.8% for public sector investment. Of the \$37.3785 billion budget, \$14.3348 billion were allocated to central administration. Salaries represented 44.3% of government ministry budgets, and 23.1% of funds appropriated for state-run companies and agencies. (Source: El Financiero, 03/26/91)
