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MEETING OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEEOF THEBOARD OF REGENTS

The Executive Committee of the Board of Regents of the University of New Mexico, met at the University at the hour of 2:30 o'clock P. M., on July 31, 1928.

Present: Mrs. Reed Holloman, President, Mr. John F. Simms, Secretary and Treasurer; and Mrs. Laurence F. Lee.

Dr. Zimmerman reported that he had entered into a working arrangement with Dr. Hewett and Mr. Walter of Santa Fe whereby the press owned by the School of American Research and operated by the museum at state expense is to be used for University publications on a cost basis during the coming year or until such time as the University desires to cancel the arrangement, which plan was by the Executive Committee approved.

Dr. Zimmerman reported that in accordance with previous approval of the Board of Regents, the services of Dr. James R. Scott had been engaged as Head of the Department of Health Education in the University. Dr. Zimmerman stated that this plan met with the approval of the State Health Bureau, and that the plan of cooperation involves the teaching of at least two courses a semester for the entire year by Dr. Scott, the teaching of a course in Bacteriology by Miss Greenfield, and a course in Sanitary Engineering to be given by Mr. Fox, State Sanitary Engineer, the cost to the University to be \$1200.00 paid to Dr. Scott which goes into the treasury of the County Health Office toward the payment of a nurse to assist Dr. Scott in his county health work. Dr. Zimmerman also reported that he had engaged the services of Miss Dorothea Fricke as Instructor in Art in the University. Thereupon, the Committee by unanimous vote, approved the appointments of Dr. Scott and Miss Fricke.
