BIBLIOGRAPHY

The first larger published work of consequence by Bloom was "New Mexico under Mexican Administration, 1821-1846," published serially in *Old Santa Fé* and still the authoritative word on that phase of New Mexico history. He compiled an accurate list of governors of New Mexico, clearing up a number of disputed points. He was co-author of *New Mexico History and Civics* in 1933, used as a school text book and translated *Barreiro: Ojeada sobre Nuevo Mexico*. A fairly complete bibliography follows herewith:
