Argentine Foreign Minister Emphasizes Necessity Of Promoting "effective Political Pluralism" In Central America

At an official dinner in his honor on July 22 in Bogota, Colombia, Argentine Foreign Minister Dante Caputo emphasized the on-going efforts by Contadora and Support Group nations to assist in a peaceful solution to the Central American conflict. Latin America, he said, must promote an "effective political pluralism" in that region. Argentina, he added, stands ready to assist in all possible ways to achieve this end. Caputo received the Colombian San Carlos Great Cross for his contributions as jurist and democrat, and in Central American peace efforts. Presiding at the award dinner was Colombian Foreign Minister Julio Londono Paredes. The Argentine minister's agenda during the two-day official visit included discussions with Londono on the Central American situation, arrangements for an upcoming visit by President Raul Alfonsin to Colombia, and the establishment of a bilateral cooperation commission.
