How the Great College Game Is Played—Scientific Sport.

THE FIELD, BALL AND TEAM.

The game of football as played today, originated at Rugby, in England, but when the Americans took hold of it they improved the game so much that an Englishman would hardly recognize it as the old Rugby game. A few years ago the game was very dangerous and many players were injured for life by the rough tactics of the game. But time and experience have made changes.

Today football as played by the universities and colleges all over the United States is the most scientific game of all outdoor sports. Like all other sports it has its dangers, but taken as a whole, it is purely a manly sport. The accidents that do happen are from men playing the game who have not properly trained.

THE FIELD AND THE BALL.
The field or "gridiron," as it is called is 330 feet long and 160 feet wide and is lined off by white lines every five yards.
The ball is an inflated rubber ball encased in an oval-shaped leather cover and weighing about eighteen ounces.

THE TEAM OR ELEVEN.
The football team or eleven consists of eleven players, seven forwards and four backs, known as follows: The front-most are the tackle, the guard, the center, right and left guards on each side of the center; right and left tackles on the right and left of the guards respectively; right and left ends who play a little back of the tackle; a quarter-back directly back of the center and who passes the ball from the center to the man running with it; the full-back, whose position is directly back of the quarter-back and who may run with the ball and does the kicking; right and left half-backs, who stand a little back of the full-back and either side of him.

The following is a diagram of each eleven as it lines up on the field. The crosses representing the men.

LAND LEASES.

Land Commissioner A. A. Keen has received thirty-two school land leases, approved by the secretary of the interior. The land leases are located in almost every part of the territory. The leases were forwarded to applicants today.

GRAZING ON FOREST RESERVES.
Superintendent of Forest Reserves I. B. Hanna received final orders from the secretary of the interior not to permit any school land grazing on the Gila forest reserve for 1901. The interior department is taking up reserve after reserve, and is investigating conditions on them in reference to the grazing question. Thus far the Grand Canyon reserve in Arizona and the Gila reserve in New Mexico have been examined in the southwest, and the grazing of sheep and goats prohibited on them. There are about 5,000 sheep in the Gila reserve and several thousand goats, for which a new range has to be found or they must be disposed of by their owners.
