On April 23, the Ministry of Communications and Transportation reported that air carriers Aerovias de Mexico (Aeromexico), Mexicana de Aviacion, and Aeropuertos y Servicios Auxiliares had agreed to pool material, human and technical resources to establish a single company responsible for basic airport ground support services. Services include passenger and baggage documentation, baggage loading and unloading, drinking water and electricity services, and aircraft cleaning and towing, among others.
