THE FOLLOWING BIBLIOGRAPHY is not exhaustive, but it covers general aspects of land grants in New Mexico. While the listing does not include material on all grants, many of the items do contain information on the prominent land grants. A few items on railroad land grants are also noted. Except for theses and dissertations, the bibliography is limited primarily to published secondary items. The listing is divided into bibliographies and general guides, books and theses, and essays.
