## **Federal Government Domestic Debt As Of July 31, 1992**

On Aug. 2, the Banco de Mexico (central bank) reported that the public sector's domestic debt was reduced by 28.4 trillion pesos (US\$7.78 billion) during the first seven months of the year. As of July 31, the domestic debt totaled 149.6 trillion pesos (US\$47.7 billion), compared to 178 trillion pesos (approximately US\$56 billion) at year-end 1991. At present, foreign investors hold 15% of Mexican government securities (treasury certificates, bonds, ajustabonos, treasury bonds), compared to 5.3% on Jan. 1. (Source: El Financiero, 08/03/92)
