## **Pemex Renews Negotiations With Former Employees & Fishery Industry Workers**

On Aug. 10, the state-run oil company PEMEX resumed negotiations with 9,000 former employees on severance pay and other forms of compensation, and 4,000 fishery industry workers who demand reparations for contamination of the Gulf of Mexico caused by the oil company.
