On Aug. 7, Pedro Brummer, vice president of tourism promotion for the National Chamber of Commerce Confederation (Confederacion de Camaras Nacionales de Comercio-CONCANACO), told reporters that the government has agreed to permit US and Canadian charter bus companies to operate in Mexico. He added that the accord stems from negotiations for the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA). The agreement takes effect in September. (Source: La Jornada, 08/08/92)
