Productivity Improvement Surpasses U.S. & Canadian Rates

According to results of a study released Aug. 20 by the Private Sector Economic Studies Center (Centro de Estudios Economicos del Sector Privado-CEESP), overall productivity rose 20% over the past three years, compared to 3% in the US, and 1.5% in Canada. CEESP also reported that private sector investment in Mexico increased at an annual rate of 14%. In addition, growth in real wages was calculated at an average 4.9% per year.
