South Korean Government To Support Mexican Membership In Pacific Rim Cooperation Organization

On Aug. 19 in Seoul, South Korean foreign ministry sources reported that the Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) forum will consider Mexican membership at a meeting scheduled for Sept. 10-11 in Bangkok (Thailand). The APEC was established in 1989 in Singapore to promote trade and other exchanges among Pacific Rim nations. Member-nations include South Korea, China, Japan, Australia, New Zealand, Taiwan, Hong Kong, Canada, Thailand, Malaysia, Indonesia, Singapore, Brunei, the Philippines, and the US.
