## **Modifications In Foreign Investment Legislation Expected By Year-end**

On Aug. 19, Javier Garduno, chair of the Chamber of Deputies trade commission, told reporters that lawmakers plan to approve new legislation on foreign investment by year-end. The changes will specify higher proportions of foreign capital participation in several industries defined in the constitution as crucial to the national interest. In other industries, foreign investors can acquire a 100% stake. Only US and Canadian investors will receive the same treatment as domestic counterparts.
