On June 1, the bodies of three residents of Apopa, a San Salvador suburb, were found after they had been "disappeared" by death squads. According to the New York Times (06/07/88), they joined those of more than 40 other recent bullet-ridden corpses found recently. Witnesses of one such incident in Morazan department said soldiers forced two men to run through a burning field, then chopped of their noses, fingers and ears before shooting them.
