## **Salvadoran Congress Ratifies Central American Parliament**

On Sept. 3, the Salvadoran National Assembly ratified the creation of a Central American Parliament, as specified in the Esquipulas II regional peace accords. The accords were signed in August last year by President Jose Napoleon Duarte and his four Central American counterparts. The vote was 47 in favor, zero against.
