In a statement made in Puerto Cabezas on Sept. 2, Interior Minister Tomas Borge said elections of political representatives for the Atlantic coast autonomous region will take place within the next six months, immediately before or after Holy Week. Borge's announcement was made during a speech at a celebration marking the first anniversary of the National Assembly's approval of regional autonomy statutes.
