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Pemex Production, January-september 1992

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According to a Nov. 9 report, the state-owned oil company PEMEX produced a daily average 2.674 million barrels of crude oil over the first nine months of the year. The average output of light and extra-light crude (Istmo and Olmecca) came to 1.375 million bpd, and heavy crude (Maya), 1.299 million bpd. About 93.5% of the oil came from the southeastern states of Campeche, Chiapas and Tabasco. January-September exports amounted to 1.374 million bpd.
