## **Salinas De Gortari Proposes 20-peso Coin**

On Nov. 4, President Carlos Salinas de Gortari sent a legislative decree to the Senate seeking the creation of a new 20-peso coin. According to a presidential spokesperson, the coin would be produced with two different metallic alloys. This eliminates the possibility the coin's metallic value would be worth more than its nominal value and also reduces the chance of counterfeit reproduction. The coin will bear the image of Mexican independence hero Miguel Hidalgo y Costilla. (Source: Notimex, 11/04/92)
