During a press conference transmitted to Latin America Dec. 10 via satellite, second vice president of Chase Manhattan Bank, Guy Loret de Mola, said that US banks will reserve severe treatment for "irresponsible countries" in matters related to foreign debt payments. In the short term, he said, the nations that formally meet their debt service obligations will receive a more positive refinancing treatment. (Basic data from Notimex, 12/10/88)
