On Dec. 23, terrorists set off three bombs at the National University in San Salvador, blowing up a biology laboratory, according to university rector Luis Argueta Antillon. A watchman, Roberto Aguirre, was also shot to death. No one took responsibility and police said they had no clues. Argueta Antillon accused the military, the government and right-wing terrorists of responsibility, but offered no evidence. (Basic data from AP, 12/23/88)
