El Salvador: Four Die In Explosions In San Miguel

On Jan. 8, El Salvador's Armed Forces Press Committee (COPREFA) reported that rebels detonated a car bomb and several other explosive devices in the city of San Miguel, 138 km. east of the capital. Three rebels and a National Police explosives expert were killed. A spokesperson, who requested anonymity, said the policeman was killed when he tried to deactivate a bomb hidden inside an agricultural market in San Miguel. The three guerrillas died when the car bomb exploded, he said. (Basic data from Notimex, AP, 01/08/89)
