## **Central America Summit Date Not Yet Established**

On Jan. 11, a Costa Rican Foreign Ministry spokesperson said that Feb. 20 is a likely date for the Central American summit in San Salvador. During the week, he said, Costa Rican President Oscar Arias spoke via telephone several times with Nicaraguan counterpart, Daniel Ortega. The two leaders reportedly agreed on the second half of February for rescheduling the summit, and Arias suggested Feb. 20. In Managua on Jan. 12, a communique by President Ortega said that no dates, tentative or otherwise, had been established for the summit meeting. (Basic data from Notimex, 01/11/89, 01/12/89)
