Cuba Ships Construction Materials To Nicaragua

The Cuban government has earmarked some 30,000 metric tons of construction materials to build 1,000 homes in the Atlantic coastal town of Bluefields which was destroyed by Hurricane Joan in October. On Jan. 11, a Cuban construction brigade arrived in Bluefields. According to the Caribbean Shipping Company the first shipment was dispatched Jan. 13, and another 12,000 metric tons of donated equipment will be shipped before April, the start of the rainy season.
