

Peru: Note Guerrilla Attack

On Jan. 22, suspected Sendero Luminoso guerrillas fired into a crowd in Huancayo, resulting in the deaths of three people and 15 wounded. According to police, about 1,000 shantytown residents were participating in an outdoor community meeting with the mayor, Ricardo Bohoquez. Eight gunmen opened fire on the crowd with pistols and machine guns, and later threw dynamite. Police said Bohoquez was the target of the attack. He was wounded twice in the chest.
