On Jan. 28, the Simon Bolivar National Guerrilla Coordinator issued a call for all rebel group leaders to meet in an effort to elaborate a consensus position on the government's proposal for dialogue. The meeting would focus on developing a joint statement on the national conditions, reconciliation with the government and other social groups, and the peace process.
