For FY1990, the Reagan administration requested \$386 million for El Salvador (\$287.5 million in economic aid; \$98.5 million, military); Honduras, \$207 million (\$146 million economic; \$61 million, military); and Guatemala (\$158.5 million, economic; \$9.5 million, military). A total of \$83 million was earmarked for Costa Rica, a reduction of \$7 million compared to FY1988. (Basic data from 01/19/89 report by CRIES, Managua)
