## **Argentine President Cancels Plans To Attend Inauguration Ceremonies In Caracas**

On Jan. 30, Argentine President Raul Alfonsin canceled plans to attend the Feb. 2 inauguration of Venezuelan president-elect Carlos Andres Perez. According to presidential spokesperson, Jose Ignacio Lopez, Alfonsin will stay home to direct an anti-subversive campaign launched last week following an attack by suspected leftist guerrillas on a military base outside Buenos Aires.
