In a communique on Jan. 23, the Salvadoran army said that government troops had killed 50 rebels and wounded 45 in fighting last week. Army casualties, said the statement, totaled two dead and four wounded. Meanwhile, the rebels said in a broadcast by Radio Venceremos that government forces had suffered 301 casualties in the week's fighting. (Basic data from AFP, 01/23/89)
