## **U.S. Makes Another Payment Of Late U.N. Dues**

On Feb. 3, Washington's second-ranking ambassador to the United Nations, Herbert S. Okun, delivered a \$28.8 million dues check to UN Secretary General Javier Perez de Cuellar. Okun also gave Perez de Cuellar a \$7.3 million check to help pay for UN peacekeepers in Cyprus. UN financial spokesperson Fred Eckhart said the US still owes the UN \$279 million for unpaid pre-1988 dues and \$216 million for 1989 dues. (Basic data from AP, 02/03/89)
