On Jan. 31, the Nicaraguan Defense Ministry reported that four civilians were killed on Jan. 28 in La Pradera, Chontales department. According to the Ministry, a contra group violated the cease-fire. In the ensuing exchange of gun-fire between Sandinista soldiers and contras, two civilians aged 10, one age 12, and another, 17, were killed. (Basic data from Notimex, 01/31/89)
