Honduras: Jeep Carrying U.S. Army Engineers Hit By Gunfire

On Feb. 2, a jeep in a seven-vehicle convoy carrying US Army engineers was hit by gunfire in the northern department of Yoro. US Embassy attache Charles Barclay said that no one was injured, and only minor damage occurred. The convoy was crossing through Yoro, about 150 km. north of Tegucigalpa, when the last vehicle came under fire, said Barclay. The engineers had left the Palmerola base where US troops are stationed.
