Agricultural Trade Balance, January 1993

Mexico's recorded an agricultural trade surplus of US\$120 million in January 1993, almost three times higher than the figure for January 1992. According to the Agriculture Secretariat (Secretaria de Agricultura y Recursos Hidraulicos, SARH), agricultural exports totaled US\$300 million in January, compared with US\$211 million in the same month in 1992. The principal exports during the month were tomatoes, watermelon, cantaloupes, winter vegetables, strawberries and live cattle. The value of imports for the sector reached US\$180 million in January of this year, compared with US\$167 million in January 1992. (Source: Notimex, 03/31/93)
