## **Salvadoran Elections May Be Postponed**

On March 8, president of the Central Electoral Council, Ricardo Perdomo, recommended that the March 19 general elections be postponed to "avoid increased violence." Perdomo stated that political parties and government officials "have not reacted seriously to proposals to meet with the guerrillas," and requested that they "make a peace offering and seek the postponement of elections to March 31."
