On March 12, an estimated 2,000 persons participated in an anti-government demonstration in the city of Leon. Protesters demanded "the democratization of Nicaragua." The event was organized by the Nicaraguan Democratic Coordinator, a coalition of four conservative political parties, the Superior Council of Private Enterprise, and two labor confederations.
