## **Nicaraguan Government Permits Return Of Foreign Priests Expelled In 1984**

On March 15, after a meeting with Cardinal Miguel Obando y Bravo, President Daniel Ortega said that his government will permit return to Nicaragua of foreign priests expelled in July 1984 on charges of engaging in political activities. Next, Ortega said that Coprosa, a publication by the Catholic Church, could resume operations as soon as it had complied with legal requirements. He added that newscasts by Radio Catolica, suspended months ago, could be resumed under the same conditions. (Basic data from Xinhua, 03/16/89)
